



In the Matter of Land known as Pentir, Llanfihangel Cwmdu

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry Nos. 3,4,16,17,18 and 19 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.22 in the Register of Common Land formerly maintained by the Breconshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection Nos. 257,258 and 349-352 made by the Chairman of the Duke of Beaufort's Estate Commoners Association and noted in the Register on 24 August or 8 September 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Brecon on 27 October 1982. The hearing was attended by Mrs B Morgan for the Registration Authority, Mr D W Isaac and Mr J Williams, Chairman and a member respectively, for Cwmdu Community Council, Mr G W Shellard of Messrs. Henry Jones and Hobbs Solicitors of Cardiff for the Commoners Association. Mr W I Parry and Mr D H Bowen whose rights applications had become final appeared in person.

No one appeared to support any of the applications, to which objection had been made.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm any of the said registrations.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
