



In the Matter of Manorial Waste of the Ancient
Manor of Builth, Llanwrthwl

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and Entry No. 1 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 142 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Powys County Council and are occasioned by Objections No. 614 and No. 615 made by the Corporation of Birmingham and noted in the Register on 4 April 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Welshpool on 9 December 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr H J Cave of the Registration Authority. The parties had agreed to request refusal of confirmation and accordingly I refuse to confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
