



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 276/U/147

In the Matter of Siar Wald, part of the Great
Forest of Brecknock

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL.114 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Brecon County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Brecon on 24 January 1989.

At the hearing the Powys County Council as highways authority was represented by Mr N M Rolt, solicitor, Mr D J Powell, solicitor of Jeffreys and Powell of Brecon represented the executive committee of the Allotment Holdings or Commoners of the Great Forest of Brecon and Mr Morgan represented the Registraion Authority.

Mr Rolt produced the Inclosure Award dated 1819 for the Great Forest of Brecon which shows that that part of the unit land shown on the plan attached to this decision (i.e. the whole of the land less a small part to the south which is shown as being allotted to Mr Parton) was allotted to the Surveyor of roads. It thus became by statute vested in the Powys County Council as Highways Authority, in the same way as the land referred to in my decision reference No. 276/U/144.

On this evidence I am satisfied that the Powys County Council are the owners of the land shown on that plan. I shall accordingly direct the Registration Authority to register that Council as owners under Section 8(2) of the Act of 1965.

The small part shown on the plan as having been allotted to Mr Parton will remain subject to protection under section 9 of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
