

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 58/D/23

In the Matter of The Begwns
Llandewifach and Llowes, Powys

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 25 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL.12 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Powys County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 823 made by Begwns Commoners Association and noted in the Register on 30 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Llandrindod Wells on 7 January 1975. The hearing was attended by the applicant, Mr. D M Price, and by Mr. E R Lewis on behalf of the Objector.

The Applicant told me that he did not wish to pursue the claim for rights of common in respect of Travelly Farm.

For this reason I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
