



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos 58/D/28-29

In the Matter of The Begwns,  
Llandewifach and Llowes, Powys

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 43 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL.12 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Powys County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 577 made by H A Nicholls & Sons and noted in the Register on 29 September 1970 and by Objection No. 826 made by Begwns Commoners Association and noted in the Register on 30 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Llandrindod Wells on 7 January 1975. The hearing was attended by the applicant and by representatives of the Objectors.

I was informed that since the registration the greater part of the farm, Wern-Newydd - that is, some 117 acres - had been sold to W A and K R Lloyd of Painscastle and the the remainder had been sold to a Mr. Brereton.

Approximately 80 acres of this farm is situated in the Parish of Clyro and it was common ground before me that there was no right of common over the Begwns in respect of these 80 acres. On this footing it was agreed that the registration should be confirmed subject to the modification stated below.

For these reasons, I confirm the registration with the following modification, that I delete the figures and words "420 sheep, 14 cows and 28 horses" from the fourth column of the Register and substitute "180 sheep, 6 cattle, and 12 ponies".

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
