

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Ncs 58/D/32-33

In the Matter of The Begwns, Llandewifach and Llowes, Powys

DECISION

The se disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 48 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL.12 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Powys County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 634 made by Major G W F de Winton and noted in the Register on 29 September 1970 and by Objection No. 833 made by Begwns Commoners Association and noted in the Register on 30 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputesat Llandrindod Wells on 7 January 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr. V.G. Jones F.R.I.C.S. on behalf of the Applicants and by Mr. Gareth Morris, Solicitor of the firm of Messrs. Dilwyn Jones & Sons on behalf of Major de Winton and by Mr. E R Lewis on behalf of Begwns Commoners Association.

These disputes were heard in conjunction with references 58/D/30-31. The evidence and submissions were identical.

For the reasons appearing from my decision under the references 58/D/30-31, I confir the registration subject to the like modifications as in the case of the registration at Entry No. 47.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
