



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 276/D/355 and 356

In the Matter of Tract of land near
Abercrave Station, Ystradgynlais Higher
Brecknock D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entries No. 1 in the Land and ownership sections of Register Unit No. CL.136 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Breconshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 578 made by the National Coal Board and noted in the Register on 18 November 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Brecon on 13 June 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr J Cockle on behalf of the Eagle Star Insurance Company Limited who registered the land as common land and claim ownership in the ownership section of the Register and by Mr J R Davies Clerk to the Community Council.

The ~~objector~~ told me that he had evidence that the Coal Board had no title to the land which by its objection it claimed to own. In the absence of the Coal Board I cannot sustain its objection and I therefore treat the registrations as unopposed and confirm both registrations.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
