DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No.CL.41 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Montgomeryshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 189 made by Rt.Hon Lord Davies and noted in the Register on 16 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Welshpool on 14 June 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr J I Williams of Messrs. Longueville and Co on behalf of Col Watkins Williams Wynn who made the Entry No 1 in the Ownership Section and Mr C Tomley of Messrs. Williams Gittins and Tomley on behalf of Lord Davies.

Mr Williams withdrew the Entry.

For this reason I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
