



In the Matter of Y Figyn, Castle Caereinion
and Guildsfield Without

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and Entry Nos. 1-8 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 2 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Montgomeryshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection 76 made by J N Robinson and noted in the Register on 2 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Welshpool on 4 June 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr E B Roberts, Solicitor, appearing on behalf of the Objector and of the applicants for registration of Rights Nos. 2, 3 and 6 (or their successors); by Mr G A Landés, Solicitor, appearing on behalf of the applicant for registration of Right No. 8 and by Mr R H Francis, applicant for registration of Right No. 5. There was no appearance by the applicants for registration of Rights Nos. 1, 4 and 7.

The Objection relates to a small section of the land at its north-western corner; the section being edged red on the plan attached to the Objection. The Objection was not opposed by any of the Rights holders present or represented, and I shall confirm the registrations with the modification that the section to which the Objection relates be excluded from the land comprised in this Unit.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
