



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the matter of Little Drayton Recreation
Ground, Market Drayton, North Shropshire D.,
Salop

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Little Drayton Recreation Ground, Market Drayton, North Shropshire District being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG.23 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Salop County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no one claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Shrewsbury on 9th April 1975. Mrs. Bevan clerk to the Market Drayton Parish Council produced a certified copy of the Little Drayton Inclosure Award with map attached whereby the land in question (No. 95 on the said map) was allotted to the Churchwardens and Overseers of Little Drayton.

For these reasons I am satisfied that Market Drayton Parish Council is the owner of the land and I shall accordingly direct the Salop County Council, as registration authority, to register Market Drayton Parish Council as the owner of the land under section 3(2) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
