## In the Matter of The Flash, Crosenere, Cockshutt, North Shropshire D., Salop

## DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as The Flash, Crosemere, Cockshutt North Shropshire District being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL.74 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Salop County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no one claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Shrewsbury on 9th April 1975. There was no appearance at the hearing.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land and it will therefore remain subject to protection under section 9 of the Act of 1985.

I am required by regulation 50(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to emplain that a person as rieved by this isoision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 5 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is safet to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Tourt.
