



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL.226 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Somerset County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. O/94 made by Sir N.J. Mordaunt Bart and noted in the Register on 5th November 1970 and objection No. O/804 made by the Somerset County Council and noted in the Register on 22nd August 1972.

All persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of these disputes have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons.

I am satisfied that there is no person who, if a hearing were held, would be entitled to be heard upon giving his name and address to me and satisfying me that he had succeeded to the interest, or part of the interest of any other person.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly refuse to confirm the registrations at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section of the said Register Unit.
