DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No.V.G.31 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the West Suffolk County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 0/62 made by Mr. W. Hills, Objection No. 0/69 made by Mrs. Irene Beevis, and Objection No. 0/70 made by the late Mrs. Elsie E. Marshall, all which Objections were noted in the Register on 30th September 1970. All these matters were consolidated by an order dated ~~31st~~ January 1973.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons.
