



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos 36/D/8 and 9

In the Matter of Banks Lane, from
Effingham Common to Banks Common
Effingham, Surrey

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL.60 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 52 made by British Railways and noted in the Register on 17th March 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 25th March 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr. A.G. Estler the applicant for registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section. British Railways ~~by~~ by a letter dated 2 August 1973 addressed to the Surrey County Council withdrew their objection No. 52 and subsequent to the hearing I have been provided with consents which would have enabled me to confirm the registrations without a hearing.

For these reasons I confirm the two above mentioned Registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
