



In the Matter of Bisley Common, including Reidon Hill,  
Bisley, Surrey (No. 1)

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 26 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 111 made by the former Woking Urban District Council and noted in the Register on 22 July 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 21 May 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr G Wilson, solicitor, on behalf of the applicants for the registrations at Entry Nos 1, 2, 3, and 7 in the Rights section of the Register Unit, by Mr R G Smith, solicitor, on behalf of the Woking Borough Council, and by Mr B Cotter, solicitor, on behalf of the Surrey County Council, and Mrs Martin, the successor in title of the applicants for the registrations at Entry Nos 5 and 6 in the Rights section of the Register Unit appeared in person.

Mr Smith informed me that it had been agreed that the land the subject of the Objection should be excluded from the registration.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modification:- namely, the exclusion of the land the subject of the Objection.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
