

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 236/D/174

In the Matter of Broad Street Common, Worplesdon, Surrey (NO. 2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos 1 to 12 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.18 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objections Nos 253 and 408 made by the former Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 21 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 27 April 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr P F Myers, Solicitor, on behalf of the Surrey County Council. There was no appearance by or on behalf of any of the applicants for the registrations, but Mr Myers produced documents signed by all of them on the basis of which I confirm the registration at Entry Mo. 1 with the following modification, namely, the substitution of the words "The right to pasture one horse and one cow over the whole of the land comprised in this Register Unit" for the words in column 4; I refuse to confirm the registrations at Entry Nos 2 and 12; I confirm the registrations at Entry Nos 3,4,7,8,9,10, and 11 with the following modifications, namely, the substitution in each case of the words "The right of pannage or pasture for 2 swine or other cattle over the whole of the land comprised in this register unit" for the words in column 4; I confirm the registration at Entry No. 5 with the following modification, namely, the deletion of the words "together with the right of estovers"; and I confirm the registration at Entry No. 6 with the following modification, namely, the substitution of the words "The right to graze 50 cattle or 100 sheep over the whole of the land comprised in this Register Unit and Register Units CL.11 and CL.46".

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
