



In the Matter of Chiddingfold Green, Chiddingfold,
Surrey (No. 1)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG107 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Surrey County Council and are occasioned by Objection No 704 made by the former Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 1 August 1972 and the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 167 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 20 January 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr A R Hart, solicitor, on behalf of the Waverley District Council, the successor authority of the former Eambleton Rural District Council, the applicant for both the registration and the conflicting registration, and by Mr B R Cotter, solicitor, on behalf of the Surrey County Council.

Mr Hart informed me that he was instructed not to support the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
