



In the Matter of Hill Grove Recreation  
Ground at the junction of Whyteleafe Road  
and Salmons Lane, West Caterham, Tandridge D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 66 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 89 made by Caterham and Warlingham Urban District Council and noted in the Register on 15 May 1970.

I held a hearing (adjourned from 26 June 1981) for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dorking on 29 October 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr R C Wilson, Solicitor, appearing on behalf of Tandridge District Council, successor authority to the Objector.

The registration was made on the application of Mr J E Pearce, and it had been agreed between him and the District Council, that the registration should be confirmed but modified by excluding from the land a strip fronting Salmons Lane which had been dedicated as part of the highway. Accordingly I confirm the registration with this modification.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
