

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 236/D/389

In the Matter of Hurst Green and Holland Green, Oxted, Tandridge D

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 160 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 227 made by the County Council and noted in the Register on 15 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Oxted on 24 June 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr B E H Cotter, Solicitor, of Surrey County Council and by Mr R C Wilson, Solicitor of Tandridge District Council, the successor authority to Godstone Rural District Council, the applicant for registration.

The Objection relates to strips of land claimed to be highway or highway verges: the strips are shown on a plan produced at the hearing. Mr Wilson agreed to the exclusion of these strips from the registration and accordingly I confirm the registration modified by excluding the strips from the land comprised in the Register Unit.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me so state a case for the decision of the High Court.
