



In the Matter of Land at Bullbeggars Lane,
Horsell, Woking, Surrey (No. 2).

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos 1 - 3 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 239 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 127 made by the former Woking Urban District Council and noted in the Register on 22 July 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 6 October 1977. The hearing was attended by Mrs E M J Seymour, the widow of Mr A J Seymour, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 1, and the Woking Borough Council was represented by Mr R A Payne, its Principal Legal Assistant. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Mr H Davis, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 2, or by Mr and Mrs S J Fidler, the applicants for the registration at Entry No. 3.

On the evidence referred to in my decision in In the Matter of Land at Bullbeggars Lane, Horsell, Woking (No. 1), (1977) Ref. No. 236/D/140 I find this land to form part of a highway. In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
