



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 236/W/130

In the Matter of Land at the Junction of Barf's  
Lane and Littlewick Road, Woking, Surrey

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land at the junction of Barf's Lane and Littlewick Road, Woking, being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL.111 in the Register of Common Land of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no one claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Guildford on 12 December 1979. At the hearing, the Woking Borough Council was represented by Mr C Gilmour, Solicitor, and Mr P R Hogbin, the successor in title of the applicants for a registration in the Rights Section of the Register Unit, appeared in person, but neither Mr Gilmour nor Mr Hogbin had any evidence as to the ownership of the land in question.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and it will therefore remain subject to protection under section 9 of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
