



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of land at Wood Street,  
Worplesdon, Surrey (No. 2)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry Nos 1 to 7 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 73 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 256 made by the former Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 21 September 1970 and the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 39 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons.

I am satisfied that there is no person who, if a hearing were held, would be entitled to be heard upon giving his name and address to me and satisfying me that he had succeeded to the interest, or part of the interest of any other person.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly confirm the registration with the following modifications:- namely the substitution in respect of each registration of the words "The right of pannage or pasture for two swine or other cattle over the whole of the land comprised in this Register Unit" for the words in column 4.
