



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Land near Church,  
Chelsham, Tandridge <sup>D</sup>

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 480 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 676 made by Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 1 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Extd on 25 June 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr T Oakey Chairman of Chelsham and Farleigh Parish Council (successor to the applicant for registration) and by Mr B E H Cotter, Solicitor, of Surrey County Council. In accordance with a written request signed by the parties concerned, I confirm the registration modified by excluding from the land the area coloured pink on the plan attached to the Objection.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
