



In the Matter of Land near Pierre Port Farm
adjacent to Chaters Firs, Frensham, Waverley D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 440 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 628 made by Hambledon Rural District Council and noted in the Register on 3 July 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 10 November 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr R A Hart, Solicitor, of Waverley District Council, the successor Authority to Hambledon Rural District Council; and by Mr Godfrey, Solicitor, of the firm of W H Hadfield and Son.

Registration at Entry No. 1 was made on the application of Mrs D E C Wylie. Mr Godfrey told me that Mrs Wylie had since died and that he acted for the Wylie family, who did not propose to pursue the application. In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
