



In the Matter of Manorial Waste, Chiddingfold,

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.168 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 155 made by the former Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 1 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 21 March 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr R Hart, Solicitor, on behalf of the Waverley District Council, the successor authority of the former Hambledon Rural District Council, the applicant for the registration, and Mr B E H Cotter, Solicitor, on behalf of the Surrey County Council.

Mr Hart and Mr Cotter informed me that it had been agreed that only two areas of land should remain in the Register Unit.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modification: namely, the exclusion of all the land comprised in the Register Unit with the exception of the land lying behind (a) the foot of the bank in Killinghurst Lane West of Chafleshurst Cottages, and (b) the ditch adjoining Whitebeech Lane and High Street, including the length along High Street Green and north-east of the junction with Whitebeech Lane.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
