



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 236/D/618

In the Matter of Manorial Waste in
Elstead, Waverley D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 235 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 106 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 4 March 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr B E H Cotter, Solicitor, of the County Council and Mr A R Hart, Solicitor, of Waverley District Council, successor authority to Hambledon RDC, the applicant for registration.

Mr Hart asked for the VG registration to be confirmed, and accordingly I confirm the CL registration modified by excluding from this registration the land comprised in the VG registration (such exclusion to extend to the parts excluded from the VG registration by my decision dated 6 April 1981 Reference 236/D/619-620).

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
