



In the Matter of Manorial Waste near  
Norley Common, Womersh, Waverley D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 174 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 366 made by Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 15 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 3 February 1981. The ~~objection~~<sup>Surrey County Council</sup> was represented by Mr D C Rice, Solicitor, and Waverley District Council by Mr R A Hart, Solicitor.

The registration was made on the application of Hambledon RDC, to which Waverley District Council is successor.

The Unit land consists of a number of small pieces of land, not contiguous or adjacent. Mr Hart did not resist the Objection and in these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
