



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 236/D/47

In the Matter of Parish Land, Chobham
Road, Ottershaw, Runnymede District,
Surrey

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No CH. 331 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 93 made on behalf of Chertsey Pools Allotment Charity Trustees.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 18 October 1977. At the hearing the Trustees were represented by Mr T E Prowse Chartered Surveyor of Prowse & Partners of 3 Church Street, Staines. Before the hearing Mr J Hussey on whose application the registration was made (the application was on behalf of Ottershaw and District Society) on 9 September 1977 by telephone informed the office of the Commons Commissioners that the Society had been disbanded and the Charity Commissioners on 14 October 1977 by letter requested an adjournment as they wished for time in which to prepare an affidavit as to the land forming part of the endowment of the Charity.

At the hearing, with the agreement of Mr Prowse, I adjourned the proceedings.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the adjourned hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons, such terms being that the confirmation of the registration be refused.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly refuse to confirm the registration.
