



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 236/D/621-622

In the Matter of Part of Hankley Common,  
near West Brook Farm, Elstead, Waverley D

---

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 233 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 27 made by Annie M Billmeir and Objection No. 389 made by the County Council, noted in the Register respectively on 23 May 1969 and 16 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 4 March 1981. The hearing was attended by Miss C A P Williams, Solicitor, appearing on behalf of Annie M Billmeir's successor, Mr E R G Billmeir: by Mr B E H Cotter, Solicitor, of Surrey County Council: and by Mr A R Hart, Solicitor, of Waverley District Council, successor authority to Hambledon RDC, the applicant for the registration.

Objection No. 27 relates to a part of the land comprised in the Register Unit ("the Unit land") such part being the field shown on the plan annexed to the Objection. Objection No. 389 relates to a part claimed to be highway shown on a plan produced at the hearing. The District Council accepted the Objections and accordingly I confirm the registration modified by excluding the two parts from the Unit land.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
