



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 236/D/390-392

In the Matter of Parts of Pastens Road, Limpsfield  
Common, Limpsfield

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL.306 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 9 made by Limpsfield Parish Council and noted in the Register on 14 October 1968 and two Objections No. 325 and No. 362 both made by Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 9 October 1970 and 20 October 1969 respectively.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Oxted on 8 May 1981. The hearing was attended by Mrs A Williams, Solicitor, of the Parish Council and by Mr B Cotter, Solicitor, of Surrey County Council.

The registration was made on the application of Mr L J Hall, who was not present or represented. There are no rights of common registered.

The land is a small narrow strip on the edge of the highway and in the absence of evidence that it is waste land of a manor and qualifies for registration on that ground, I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law, may within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
