

In the Matter of Reigate Heath
and Trumpets Hill, Reigate and
Banstead Borough, Surrey

DECISION

These ^{two} disputes relate to the registrations at Entry Nos 1 and 2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL 38 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and ~~is~~^{are} occasioned by Objection Nos 269 and 270 made by Reigate Borough Council and noted in the Register on 25 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Guildford on 8 November 1978. At the hearing Reigate and Banstead Borough Council were represented by Mrs M G Wilcock their Senior Solicitor.

The registration at Entry No 1 was made on the application of Mr R C Ford and is of a right of estovers and turbary attached to 7 Skimmington Cottages. The registration at Entry No 2 was made on the application of Mrs E A Basting and is of a right to graze 4 horses and of estovers attached to Bonny Cottage.

Mrs Wilcock produced a document signed by Mrs Jessie Louise Ford as successor of Mr R C Ford and another document signed by Mrs E A Basting requesting me to delete Entry Nos 1 and 2 respectively. In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1978 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
