In the Matter of St Peter's Green (part),  
Tandridge

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 518 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 573 made by Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 26 May 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Oxted on 25 June 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr B E H Cotter, Solicitor, of the County Council, Mr P G Forsyth, Clerk to Tandridge Parish Council, the applicant for registration, and by Mr P A Slegg. There are no rights of common registered. It appears that this small area of land was purchased by Mr Slegg in 1978, and Mr Forsyth said that the Parish Council did not now seek to maintain the registration as common land. In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
