



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of The Ten Acre Boundstone (part), Little
Switzerland and Lower Bourne (excluding 4-10 Grovelands),

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 457 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 746 made by the County Council and noted in the Register on 1 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 6 April 1982. The hearing was attended by Mrs E M Manning, the applicant for registration, in person and by Mr B H Cotter, Solicitor of and representing the County Council.

Parts of the area originally registered have been already excluded from the land registered, and the County Council is now prepared to withdraw its Objection as regards the remainder. In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
