



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 187 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 375 made by the County Council and noted in the Register on 15 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 4 March 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr B E H Cotter, Solicitor, of Surrey County Council, and by Mr A R Hart, Solicitor, of Waverley District Council, successor to Hambleton RDC, the applicant for registration.

The Objection relates to areas claimed to be highway, shown on a plan produced at the hearing. The District Council accepts the Objection and accordingly I confirm the registration modified by excluding these areas from the Unit land.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
