



In the Matter of Tilford Common, Tilford, Surrey (No. 2)

## DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG 62 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Surrey County Council and are occasioned by Objection No 309 made by the Conservators of the River Thames and noted in the Register on 2 October 1970, Objection No. 582 made by the former Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 30 May 1972 and the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 243 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 21 May 1981. The hearing was attended by Mrs P W Nice, the Clerk of the Tilford Parish Council, the applicant for the registration, by Mr B Cotter, solicitor, on behalf of the Surrey County Council, and by Miss A M Deacon, solicitor, on behalf of the Waverley District Council, the successor authority of the former Hambledon Rural District Council, the applicant for the conflicting registration.

Miss Deacon informed me that she was instructed not to support the conflicting registration, and Mrs Nice informed me that the Parish Council was willing for land the subject of the Objections, indicated, on an agreed plan which was put in, to be excluded from the registration.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modification:- namely, the exclusion of the land shown on the agreed plan.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
