



In the Matter of Willey Green, Normandy, Surrey.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG 77 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 745 made by the former Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 2 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 20 January 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr B H Cotter, solicitor, on behalf of the Surrey County Council and by Miss E Tarr, an officer of the Guildford Borough Council. There was no appearance on behalf of the Ramblers' Association, the applicant for the registration, but Mr Cotter produced a form of consent, signed by the Secretary of the Association, requesting me to refuse to confirm the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
