

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 236/D/627

In the Matter of Witley Common, near Godalming, Waverley D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 95 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 344 made by Surrey County Council and noted in the Register on 13 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 5 March 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr B E H Cotter, Solicitor, of Surrey County Council, by Mrs G A Shipp representing the National Trust, and by Mr R A Hart, Solicitor, of Waverley District Council.

The registration was made on the application of the National Trust, and there was also an application to register by Hambledon Rural District Council. The Objection relates to strips of land claimed to be highway verge, but the County Council does not now wish to pursue the Objection. In these circumstances, I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
