



In the Matter of Wonersh Common and Manorial
Waste, Wonersh, Waverley D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 182 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Surrey County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 620 made by Hambledon Rural District Council and noted in the Register on 3 July 1972.

I held a hearing (adjourned from 3 February 1981) for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Guildford on 10 November 1981. The hearing was attended by R A Hart, Solicitor, of Waverley District Council, the successor Authority to Hambledon Rural District Council, and by Mr W D White, the applicant for registration at Entry No. 1.

The registration is of a right of herbage for 12 cows, 6 horses and 12 geese. Agreement has been reached between Mr White and the District Council for a modification of this right. I shall give effect to what has been agreed and confirm the right modified to a right of herbage for 2 cows and 1 pony.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
