

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 239/D/22-23

In the Matter of Warwick Common, Warwick, Warwickshire

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.VG.69 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Warwickshire County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 50 made by the British Waterways Board and noted in the Register on 21 June 1971 and Objection No. 54 made by the former Warwick Borough Council and noted in the Register on 15 December 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Leamington Spa on 7 December 1982. The hearing was attended by Mr H A Hosking, the President of the Warwick Society, the applicant for the registration, Miss J Doran, the Deputy Secretary of the Warwick District Council, and Mr M A Gaffney, the Town Clerk of Warwick.

Mr Hosking informed me that the Society no longer wished to support the registration, since the land is sufficiently protected under the provisions of the Warwick Corporation Act 1948 (11 & 12 Geo. VI, c. xviii).

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
