



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.38/D/63

In the Matter of Blackdown Common,
Lurgashall, West Sussex.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.177 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former West Sussex County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.476 made by the County Surveyor and noted in the Register on 23rd March 1970.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly confirm the registration with the following modifications:- namely, the exclusion of a width of highway verge on both sides of the carriageway known as Roundhurst Lane, on both sides of the carriageway known as Jays Lane, and on the north side of the carriageway known as Fernden Lane, which widths are defined in the Schedule comprised in the Objection.
