



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 238/D/189-190

In the Matter of Heyshott Green, Heyshott,
West Sussex (No. 3)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry Nos. 1 and 2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. VG 17 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the West Sussex County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 41 made by Cowdray and Dickinson Trusts Ltd and noted in the Register on 7 March 1969 and the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 218 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Chichester on 14 April 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr R Stafford, the Objectors' land agent. There was no appearance by or on behalf of either of the applicants for the registrations, but Mr Stafford informed me that it had been agreed that the Objection should not be pursued, and I have refused to confirm the conflicting registration by my decision in In the Matter of Heyshott Common, Heyshott (No. 1) (1980), Ref. No. 238/D/191.

In these circumstances I confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
