



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No CL. 283 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the West Sussex County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 529 made by the County Surveyor and noted in the Register on 6 December 1971.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons which terms are that the Commons Commissioner do confirm the registration.

I have read a letter dated 17 March 1977 from Mr Charles Moss of Hortons Farm and a letter dated 19 March 1977 from Mr I L Bedford of Garlands. In these letters the writers mention pieces of land with which each is particularly concerned. These pieces are to the north-east of and form no part of the land comprised in the Register Unit No CL. 283, so the letters I think provide no reason why I should not give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms. I am willing to give such a decision and I accordingly confirm the registration without any modification.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
