



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Manorial Waste on the

West Sussex

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.157 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the West Sussex County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 182 made by Mr P M Luttmann-Johnson and noted in the Register on 16 October 1971 and Objection No. 241 made by Mr A H Cave and noted in the Register on 21 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Chichester on 13 May 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr D.Sills, Solicitor, on behalf of Mr G C Lee-Steere, whose application was noted under section 4 (4) of the Commons Registration Act 1965. There was no appearance by or on behalf of either of the Objectors, but in a letter dated 4 March 1980 Mr Cave stated that he wished to "withdraw" his Objection.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
