



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No CL. 261 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the West Sussex County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 559 made by the County Surveyor and noted in the Register on 21 June 1972.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons, which terms are that the Commons Commissioner do confirm the registration.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly confirm the registration without any modification.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
