



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No CL. 67 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the West Sussex County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 293 made by the County Surveyor and noted in the Register on 17 November 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Midhurst on 5 October 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr R A Lester on behalf of the West Sussex County Council and Mr C H Barnes on behalf of Lodsworth Parish Council. Mr Lester withdrew the Objection made by the County Surveyor and I therefore confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
