



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 238/D/139

In the Matter of The Village Green,
Plaistow, West Sussex (No. 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 41 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the West Sussex County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 341 made by the former County Surveyor and noted in the Register on 11 December 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Chichester on 22 June 1979. The hearing was attended by Mrs G Frankland, the Commons Registration Officer of the County Council.

The Objection relates solely to certain strips of land forming part of the highway. Mrs Frankland produced letters from the Plaistow Parish Council, the applicant for the registration, and the National Trust, whose application was noted under section 4(4) of the Commons Registration Act 1965 stating that they did not wish to contest the Objection.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modification:- namely the exclusion of the land the subject of the Objection.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
