



In the Matter of land known as Applehaigh  
or Appleday Clough including The Sheepwash,

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 446 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the West Yorkshire Metropolitan County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 772 made by Peter Johnson and noted in the Register on 9 June 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bradford on 11 May 1982. The hearing was attended by Mr R Cusworth of Greaves, Atter and Beaumont, Solicitors of Wakefield appearing for the applicant Notton Parish Council and Mr P T Bryant of Bridge Sanderson and Co, Solicitors of Doncaster, appearing for the Objector.

Mr Cusworth stated that his clients withdrew their application and invited me not to confirm the registration.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
