



In the Matter of the pieces of land known
as Parish Watering Place, Collingham

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry Nos. 1 in the Land and Ownership section of Register Unit No. CL 432 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former West Riding County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 1640 and 1639 both made by J D Paterson and both noted in the Register on 14 April 1972 and by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG 136 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bradford on 12 February 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr N Dyson of Messrs Fitzgerald Harts, Solicitors of Wetherby on behalf of the Collingham with Linton Parish Council who informed me that his clients and the objectors had agreed that the applications for registration as common land and village green should be withdrawn.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm either registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
