

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos. 241/D/68-69

In the Matter of Middlehill Common, Box, Wiltshire

## DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 45 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Wiltshire County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 1 made by Mr J Farmfield and Objection No. 57 made by the former Wiltshire County Council, and both noted in the Register on 12 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Chippenham on 26 November 1981. The hearing was attended by Mrs M White, the Clerk of the Box Parish Council, the applicant for the registration, Mr D Faragher, Assistant Solicitor of the Wiltshire County Council, and Mr and Mrs A K Charlton, the successors in title of Mr Farnfield.

Mrs White confirmed the statement in a letter from the Solicitors acting for the Parish Council that the Parish Council did not dispute either of the Objections.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modifications, namely, the exclusion of the three areas of land the subject of the Objections.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
